

## **MULTI -PANEL DRUG TEST DIP CARD PROCEDURE SHEET**

REVIEW INSTRUCTIONS.

TEST DEVICE, PATIENT'S SAMPLE, AND CONTROLS SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO ROOM TEMPERATURE 68° - 86°F (20° - 30°) PRIOR TO TESTING. DO NOT OPEN POUCH UNTIL READY TO PERFORM THE ASSAY. DOUBLE CHECK THE EXPIRATION DATE. DO NOT USE IF THE PRODUCT IS EXPIRED.


STEP 1
COLLECT SPECIMEN

COLLECT URINE SPECIMEN IN CLEAN CONTAINER.
RECOMMENDED LEVEL OF URINE IS 30 ML.

STEP 2

REMOVE CAP

REMOVE CAP FROM THE DIP CARD.




## STEP 3 IMMERSE DIP CARD

IMMERSE POINTED END OF TEST STRIP IN CONTAINER OF URINE.

DO NOT TOUCH PLASTIC WITH URINE.

LEAVE IN FOR 20-30 SECONDS.



NEGATIVE RESULTS
WILL APPEAR ALMOST
IMMEDIATELY.
POSITIVE RESULTS AT FIVE MINUTES.



## STEP 4 REMOVE DIP CARD

REMOVE DIP CARD AND REPLACE CAP.
PLACE FLAT ON DRY,
NON-ABSORBENT SURFACE AND WAIT FOR RESULTS.

**POSITIVE:** A ROSE-PINK BAND IS VISIBLE IN EACH CONTROL ZONE (TOP BAND) WITH NO COLOR BAND APPEARING IN THE APPROPRIATE TEST ZONE (BOTTOM BAND).

**NEGATIVE:** A ROSE-PINK BAND IS VISIBLE IN EACH CONTROL ZONE (TOP BAND) AND IN THE APPROPRIATE TEST ZONE (BOTTOM BAND). A FAINT, FADED, OR BROKEN BAND IS NEGATIVE.

INVALID: A COLOR BAND IS NOT VISIBLE IN EACH OF THE CONTROL ZONES OR NO CONTROL BAND.
